WHO CAN ATTEND ROSIE’S GIRLS?

Girls entering 6th, 7th or 8th grade.

DOES MY CHILD NEED TO ATTEND ALL THREE WEEKS?

Yes. The program is designed as a three week experience and works best when campers attend the whole time.

WHY ROSIE?

Rosie’s Girls takes its name from Rosie the Riveter, the fictional World War II icon who represented the women who went to work in shipyards and factories to fill shortages while men fought overseas. In addition, she represents all that women and girls are capable of!

WHY GIRLS?

Growing up as a girl isn’t always easy and it can be helpful to have a safe space to learn, grow and try new things. All girls learning environments give girls a chance to shine, be in the spotlight, take positive risks, and gain important leadership skills.

WHAT ABOUT SAFETY?

Your daughter’s safety is our very first priority and we have an excellent track record in this regard. However, it is important for you to know that there are inherent risks associated in working with power tools, swimming and being outdoors. We do our absolute best to manage and minimize these risks, but they cannot be eliminated entirely.
