


Google Translate: Instructions


1. Make sure you are using Google Chrome as your web browser. Download *Google Translate* [plugin](#).





Add to Chrome

2. On your computer, [go to Google Translate](#) or click the plugin in the right hand corner of your browser.



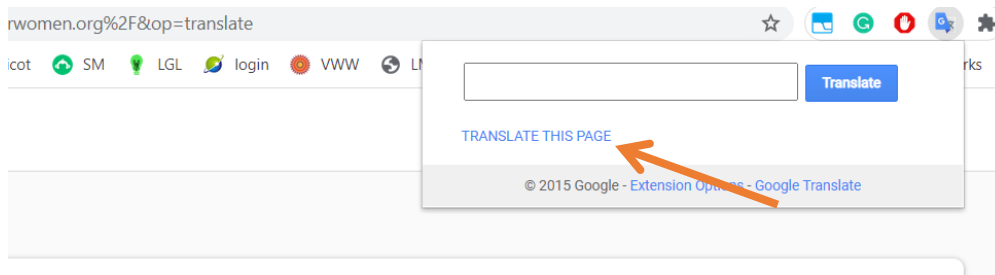
3. In the text box, enter a URL.



4. To choose the language you want to translate to, at the top right, click the down arrow .
5. On the right, click the URL that appears. The URL will open a new tab and the website will be translated.



Tip: You can also translate in your browser. Click 'TRANSLATE THIS PAGE'.

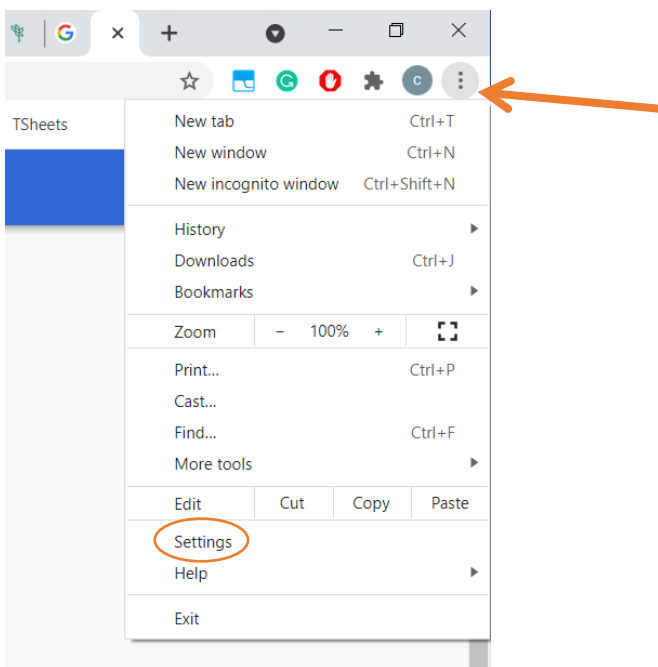


To choose the language you want to translate to, at the top right, click the down arrow ▾.

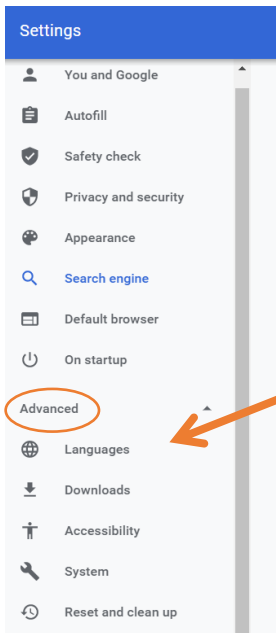



* If you want Google to **always** translate webpages in a preferred language, follow these instructions:

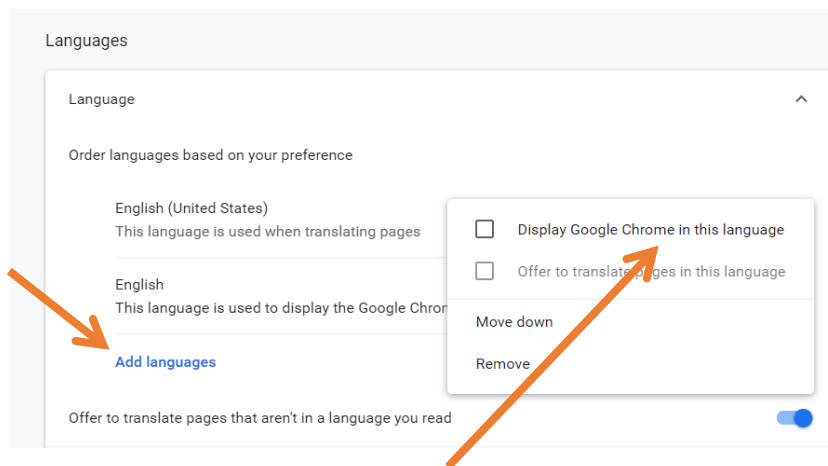
1. At the top right corner of your Google Chrome web browser, click More ⋮ > Settings.



2. At the bottom, click 'Advanced'.



3. Under 'Languages', click Language.
4. Next to the language you'd like to use, click More . If the language isn't listed, add it by clicking 'Add languages'.



5. Click Display Google Chrome in this language. Note: this option is only available on Windows computers.
6. Restart Google Chrome to apply the changes.
